
*Philosophy* = reasoning about the big questions of life – like "Is there a God?" or "How ought we to live?"

How does philosophy differ from theology, history, psychology, literature, and so on?

*Logical reasoning* (as expressed in *arguments*) goes from premises to a conclusion – and is *valid* if the conclusion logically follows from the premises:

If P is true, then Q would be true. Q is false.

 $\therefore$  P is false.

It's important to examine a view for flaws. We can show a view to be false by showing that it has false implications; and we cast doubt on the view by showing that it has doubtful implications. *Moral philosophy (ethics)* = reasoning about the big questions of morality. It has two main branches: *metaethics* and *normative ethics*.

*Metaethics* asks "What is the nature and methodology of moral judgments?"

For example, is ethics based on social conventions, individual feelings, God's will, or self-evident objective truths? *Normative ethics* asks "What principles ought we to live by?" It defends claims about four main areas:

- what actions we *ought to do*,
- what ends are *intrinsically good*,
- what character traits are *virtuous*,
- what *moral rights* we have.

*Normative ethical theory* studies general principles; *applied ethics* studies specific issues.

## Studying ethics can

- deepen our reflection on life's big questions,
- improve our moral thinking,
- enrich our professional and parental lives,
- sharpen our general thinking skills.
